House Bill 2467 (same as Senate Bill 1062) was enacted May 6, 2011.

2. To which plan types does the Virginia autism insurance law apply and what is the effective date of coverage?

3. Which autism services are required to be covered by the law?

- Diagnosis
- Behavioral health treatment
- Pharmacy care
- Psychiatric care
- Psychological care
- Therapeutic care (e.g., services provided by licensed or certified speech language pathologists, occupational therapists, physical therapists, or social workers)
- Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)

4. Does the law impose age limits or annual dollar caps on coverage?

Coverage is limited to individuals with autism between the ages of 2 through 6 years. Coverage for Applied Behavior Analysis is subject to a maximum annual benefit of \$35,000.
