When are most children properly diagnosed?

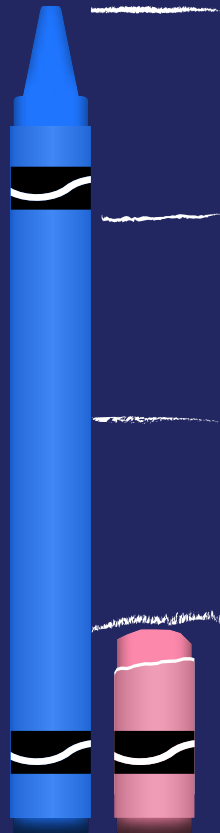
Most children aren't properly diagnosed until they are four years old! That's a problem because early detection is critical to treatment!

What is Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)?

Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a developmental disability that can cause significant social, communication, and behavioral challenges.

Autism can be reliably diagnosed as early as 18 months old

Boys are 4 times more likely to be diagnosed with ASD than Girls

## Common Early Signs of ASD

Lack of Eye Contact

Not Responding to Name

Social Withdrawal

Lack of Gestures or Pointing

Rarely Imitates Expressions
